

2012 WESTERLY FLETCHER'S RED SANTA BARBARA COUNTY



COMPOSITION

- 40% Cabernet Sauvignon
- 24% Sangiovese
- 23% Merlot
- 7% Petit Verdot
- 5% Cabernet Franc
- 1% Malbec

SEAMLESS AND QUITE RICH ON THE PALETTE, THIS WINE OFFERS A MYRIAD OF FLAVORS MANIFESTED OVER A WONDERFULLY PERSISTENT FINISH.

WINEMAKING NOTES

This wine is a unique proprietary blend of all five red Bordeaux varieties, along with a fraction of Sangiovese that results in this wine being a Santa Barbara Super-Tuscan. All of the individual lots were harvested by hand between September 10 and October 23, and then hand-sorted, de-stemmed and fermented in small stainless steel tanks. The components were racked to blend after a year in small French oak barrels, and then spent another 6 months in barrel before being bottled in July 2014.

TASTING NOTES

The 2012 Fletcher's Red is a full-bodied, gracefully styled wine. The color is a dark and brilliant ruby, with aromas of blackberry pie and toasted oak. Seamless and quite rich on the palette, this wine offers a myriad of flavors manifested over a wonderfully persistent finish. This wine should drink well for 10-15+ years.
