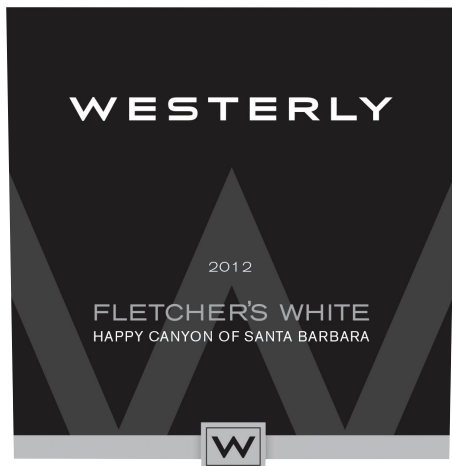

2012 WESTERLY FLETCHER'S WHITE HAPPY CANYON OF SANTA BARBARA



COMPOSITION

92% Sauvignon Blanc
8% Viognier

AROMATICS OF HONEYSUCKLE AND LEMON ZEST. THE MOUTHFEEL IS HIGHLIGHTED BY BRIGHT ACIDITY AND BALANCED, DELICATE NOTES OF GRAPEFRUIT AND LEMONGRASS.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Sourced from 15 year-old vines that were farmed at very low yields, the Sauvignon Blanc component for the 2012 Fletcher's White was harvested by hand in early September. Whole cluster pressed and then fermented in both neutral oak and stainless steel. No lees stirring. The finished wine was racked clean in early 2013 and blended with a small amount of barrel-fermented Viognier. Cold stabilized and bottled in July 2013.

TASTING NOTES

The 2012 Fletcher's White displays all the touchstone characteristics of the Happy Canyon of Santa Barbara AVA: Very light, nearly clear in color. Aromatics of white flowers, honeysuckle, and lemon zest. The mouthfeel is highlighted by bright acidity and balanced, delicate notes of grapefruit and lemongrass.
