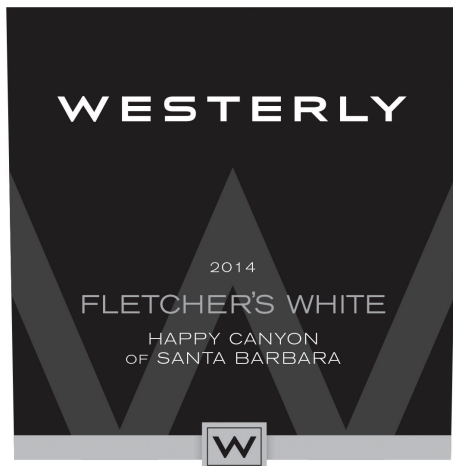

2014 WESTERLY FLETCHER'S WHITE HAPPY CANYON OF SANTA BARBARA



COMPOSITION

90% Sauvignon Blanc

10% Viognier

THERE IS A BALANCED ACID STRUCTURE PUNCTUATED WITH A FOCUSED CORE OF MELON AND WHITE NECTARINE NOTES. THE FINISH IS LONG AND BRIGHT WITH A PERSISTENT JUICINESS.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Sourced from individual blocks of Sauvignon Blanc and Viognier in Happy Canyon, the 2014 fruit was harvested by hand between August 26 and September 10, and then whole-cluster pressed and fermented in small French oak barrels (50% new). Racked to blend in January, 2015 and aged in those same barrels before being bottled in July, 2015.

TASTING NOTES

The Westerly 2014 Fletcher's White is scented of lemon peel, stone fruits, and lanolin with a hint of crushed stones. While the palate is ripe and round, there is a balanced acid structure punctuated with a focused core of melon and white nectarine notes. The finish is long and bright with a persistent juiciness.
